

Tim Moore Appointed Chairman of ADSA for the Next Two Years

The ADSA Executive Council have agreed to appointing new ADSA Chairman and Vice-Chairman for the association for 2018/2019/20. The appointments will take effect from May 1st, the date of the AGM.
